# Regulations

## **1. General Regulations:**

Arts contest is a project through which Asia's youth can display their knowledge of the Asian Games, and express their ideas on themes of the competition, terms of the competition also provide an opportunity to exchange artworks, thus the project will be benefit to the development of Intercultural Relations across countries of Asian continent. These competitions seek for the submissions that project that possess original ideas and personal view on Asian Games.

The contest gives a chance for participants to show national culture of their country, devotion to the sport and art.

## **Contest details: Asian kids Art Competition**

There are 3 competition themes one of them should form the basis for the submission

### **Themes:**

- 1. My Asian Games, my Hopes
- 2. Sport as a way of life
- 3. Our tradition our culture

## **2. Artworks requirements:**

- Entries can depict any Games-related activities e.g. Sports competitions, Games Venues, etc.
- Artworks are accepted in A3 size in both orientation (portrait or landscape).
- A soft copy of the artwork should be submitted in a CD as an illustrator file
- Artworks can be submitted in the following ways: as a stand –alone picture, as a series of panels, cartoons or comics.
- Artwork must be presented on paper, canvas, board or other two-dimensional media. No sculptures or three-dimensional artwork will be accepted.
- Artwork should be in colour
- Computer generated or computer-assisted artwork will NOT be accepted.
- Artwork should not be mounted or framed.
- Front page of the Artwork should not contain the competitors name or flag of the countries or any marks that reflects the country.
- Artwork should be the entrant's own original work and must not have been submitted to any other competition. Submitted artworks will not be returned to entrants.
- Once submitted, artwork will become the property of the Organizer who will be entitled to use the materials as it wishes, for any non-commercial purposes. Entrants will, however, retain the right of authorship.

### 3.Competition Schedule

#### **3.1 Age category of participants:**

11-15years children who were born between the years 1999 – 2003

#### **3.2 Competition zones:**

- All 45 countries of OCA
- NOC receives and registers submitted entries during the period from 1 June to 1 August 2014

#### **3.3 Judging panel:**

- A panel of judges consisting of representatives from NOC and OCA Culture Committee will define winners of the competition.
- All NOCs organize a competition and select the best one (one entry per NOC)
- A committee of 5 members will meet in early August to shortlist 10 entries from the 45 entries.
- The 10 shortlisted entries (soft copies of the paintings) are circulated among the NOCs to choose the best 5.
- The best three (first, second and third) will be chosen out of the 5 entries, during the Asian Games (Athletes will vote and select the best)

### 4. Competition Rules:

- Entrants together with submission provide the following information: name, surname, photo, date of birth (dd/mm/yy), home address, and postcode, contact telephone and email address, Name of the school and other details of the child. This information should be given on the reserve side of artwork.
- The entries for the competition are to be coded
- Entries along with the requested information are sent to the NOC of the entrant. Then after registration of the entry, NOC forwards the entrant submission to the postal address of the Organizer.
- The NOC should provide : the criteria for selection adopted by them to select the best one, name of the Jury with their position in the NOC
- Asian kids Art Competition - is non-profit. No entry fee is required.

## **5.Prizes for winners**

5.1. The winners will be awarded gold, silver and bronze medals, Certificate and cash prizes.

5.2. Winners will be announced officially on 4, October 2014 during closing ceremony of the Games.

5.3. Winners and their accompanying person are invited to participate in all events during 17th Asian Games Incheon 2014, from 19, September to 4, October 2014

Organizers will cover all expenses relating to the return air travel (economy class), hotel stay and transport during the Games.
